

Athletics Victoria Laurel Wreath Criteria

Athletics Victoria will determine the order of merit for all wreath numbers awarded in any given season.

Wreath numbers 1 to 50

Priority 1: Registered Victorian athletes who represent Australia at any of the following events in the preceding season;

- Olympic Games
- Paralympics
- Commonwealth Games
- IAAF World Athletic Championships
- IPC World Championships
- IAAF World Cross Country (Open Athlete); or
- IAAF World Walking Championships (Open Athlete)

Priority 2: Registered Victorian athletes who represent Australia at any of the following events in the preceding season;

- IAAF World Junior Championships
- Youth Olympics
- Youth Commonwealth Games
- IAAF World Cross Country (Junior Athlete)
- IAAF World Walking Championships (Junior Athlete)

Wreath numbers 51 to 350

Priority 1: Registered Victorian athletes who win an Australian title at any of the following events in the preceding season, (awarded in the following sequence, open, under 20, under 18, under 16, under 14, masters).

- Australian Track & Field Championships
- Australian Cross Country Championships
- Australian Road Running Championships

- Australian Race Walking Championships
- Australian Marathon Championships
- World Mountain Running Championships
- IAU 50km, 100km, 24 hour or Trial Championships

Priority 2: Registered Victorian athletes who win a Victorian title at any of the following events in the preceding season, (awarded in the following sequence, open, under 20, under 18, under 16, under 14).

- Victorian Open Track & Field Championships
- Victorian Junior Track & Field Championships
- Victorian Cross Country Championships
- Victorian Road Running Championships
- Victorian Race Walking Championships
- Victorian Trail Running Championships
- AMRA Mountain Running Championships
- AURA 50km, 100km, 24 & 48 hours, Trail Championships (Long & Short)
- World Masters Championships

Conditions

In any Cross Country, Road Race, Walk or Mountain Run where less than three competitors of the same age group start the race, no Laurel Wreath will be awarded.

In any Open Age or Junior Track and Field event where less than three competitors commence competition, a Laurel Wreath will only be awarded if the winner's performance is over 80% of the relevant Victorian Open or Junior State record.

In any Masters Track and Field event where less than three competitors commence competition, a Laurel Wreath will only be awarded if the winner's performance is over 80% of the relevant Age Graded performance table as issued by World Masters Athletics.
